



Bus Expectations & Consequences

Expectations of Student Behavior on Bus and Trolley

- Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- No teasing, name-calling, or cursing.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- Remain seated at all times.
- Keep all parts of your body and objects inside the bus or trolley.
- Be respectful to everyone at all times.
- Use quiet inside voices

If a student is disruptive on the bus or trolley, endangering the safety of himself/herself and/or other students, a Bus or Trolley Incident Report is written from the driver. When this occurs, the following action will be taken.

1st referral - Verbal warning to the student and consequence with a report to the parents/guardians.

2nd referral – Disciplinary action will be taken at the discretion of the School Administrator depending on the seriousness of the infraction. A report will be sent to the parents/guardians.

3rd referral – Suspension of riding privileges for the remainder of the school term will result. A report will be sent to the parents/guardians.

The School Administrator may select a different sequence in handling the event. Serious behaviors could result in immediate suspension of transportation privileges. When students are suspended from bus or trolley privileges, it is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to transport the students to and from school.
